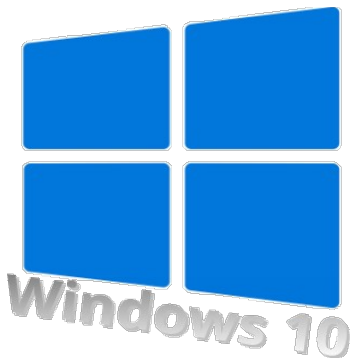


Change from Windows to Linux

From the middle of October 2026, Microsoft will no longer provide free security fixes for Windows 10.

Microsoft recommends upgrading to Windows 11. If you use an older computer, this might be not possible because Windows 11 has higher hardware requirements.

If your computer isn't compatible with Windows 11 and is not more than 12 years old, consider switching to a Linux operating system.

Linux offers following key advantages:

- Most Linux systems are free to use
- Linux is an open-source operating system, which means its source code is available to everyone
- Linux is more secure because every program requires permission from the administrator
- Updating of system software and all installed programs is done easily and quickly
- Many Linux distributions (called distros) with various choices or looks are available
- Linux offers more flexibility because you are not dependent on just one vendor
- Linux works also on older computers, as it has less hardware requirements
- It offers a better privacy of users' data as it never collects much data from the user
- Community support in forums on the web is available to help and resolve problems



Disadvantages of Linux:

- Software compatibility; not all popular programs for Windows are available in Linux

In case you use a specific software only available for Windows, check first if you find something similar for Linux.

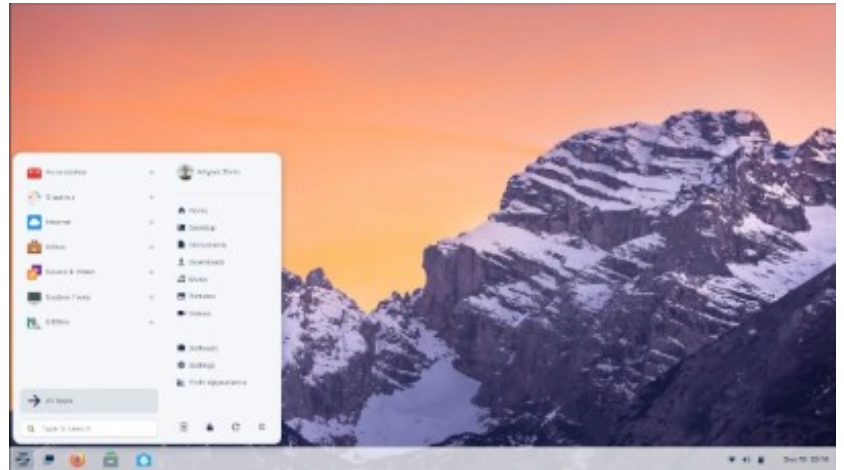
Some user friendly and easy to use Linux distros are:

In addition, Zorin comes with an application that lets users run quite many Windows programs.



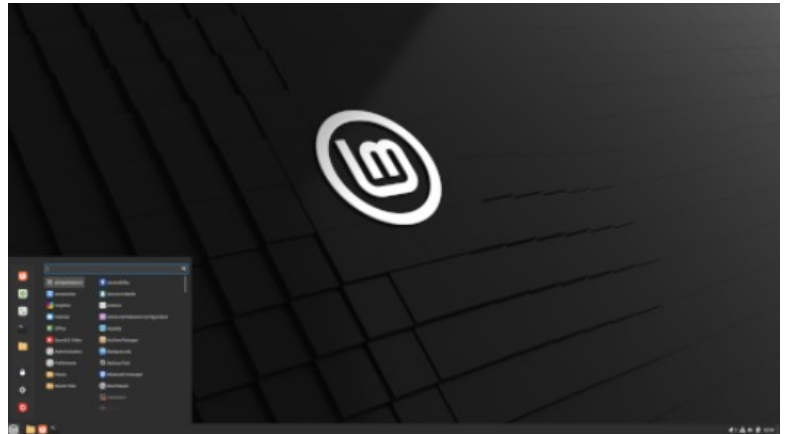

Linux Mint is an operating system for desktop and laptop computers. It is designed to work 'out of the box' and comes completely equipped with the apps most people need.

On top it comes with a custom desktop and menus, several unique configuration tools and a web-based package installation interface.
